November 25, 1835- August 11, 1919

The Andrew Carnegie Library was built in 1908. The library was named for its donor, Andrew Carnegie. Mr. Carnegie was born in 1837 in Dunfermline, Scotland. He was an American industrialist and philanthropist. Mr. Carnegie died in 1919 at the age of 84. He is buried in a cemetery in Sleepy Hollow, NY.

Mr. Carnegie donated \$12,500 which made the Andrew Carnegie Library possible. Sizable additions have been made to the Andrew Carnegie Library in 1957, 1959, and 1967.

The primary mission of the Andrew Carnegie Library is to support our private historically black institution that is secured by a strong commitment to quality instruction.
